SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION REGARDING NOTICE

I, Eric J. Miller, declare as follows:

1. I am the Senior Vice President of A.B. Data, Ltd.’s Class Action Administration Company (“A.B. Data”), whose corporate office is located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. My business address is 5080 PGA Boulevard, Suite 209, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33418.

2. I respectfully submit this supplemental Declaration in connection with the above-referenced action (the “Action”). This Declaration is based upon my personal knowledge and upon information provided by my associates and staff members. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and, if called as a witness, could and would testify competently thereto.

3. A.B. Data was appointed by the Court as the Notice and Claims Administrator in this case and completed the Court-approved notice plans in connection with class certification and the proposed Settlement. My previous declaration, *Declaration of Compliance with Notice Requirements* (ECF No. 424), dated April 10, 2026 (“Notice Compliance Declaration”), described the implementation of the Notice Plan to provide notice about the proposed Settlement to the certified class.

4. This Declaration provides the Court with updated notice and claims administration and objection information.

I. DIRECT NOTICE TO CLASS MEMBERS

5. On April 3, 2026, A.B. Data mailed the Postcard Notice via United States Postal Service (“USPS”) First-Class Mail to 43,154 entities in A.B. Data’s TPP Database and sent notice by email to 1,512 TPPs and their representatives. A.B. Data received undeliverable notices for 1% of the Postcard Notices and 7% of the email notices.

II. DIGITAL AND SOCIAL MEDIA

6. From April 3, 2026 to May 3, 2026, digital banner ads appeared on the website, ThinkAdvisor.com/life-health. The digital banner ad generated at least 77,771 impressions.

7. On April 3, 2026, A.B. Data distributed the news release via PR Newswire’s US1 Newswire to the news desks of approximately 10,000 newsrooms across the United States, and shared information about the case with its followers on X.

8. Copies of the Postcard Notice, sample banner ads, and news release were attached to my Notice Compliance Declaration.

III. TELEPHONE HELPLINE AND WEBSITE

9. A.B. Data continues to maintain the toll-free telephone number (1-877-354-3839), which became operational on November 22, 2024, and interactive voice response system to accommodate any inquiries from potential members of the Class with questions about the Notice and the Settlements. A.B. Data also continues to maintain the website TracleerLitigation.com to assist potential members of the Class with information about the Notice and the Settlement. Both the direct and indirect notices referred potential Class Members to the website. The website includes information regarding the Action, including

the claim submittal, objection filing deadline, and the date, time, and location for the Court's Final Approval Hearing.

IV. REPORT ON OBJECTIONS

10. The deadline for Class Members to object to the Settlement and/or request to speak in person at the Fairness Hearing was June 2, 2026. Objections must have been mailed to the court postmarked on or before that date. As of the date of this Declaration, A.B. Data has not received or been made aware of any objections to the Settlement and/or requests to speak in person at the Fairness Hearing.

V. ADMINISTRATIVE FEES AND COSTS

11. A.B. Data agreed to be the Notice and Claims Administrator in exchange for payment of its fees and out-of-pocket expenses. Co-Lead Counsel received reports on and invoices for the work A.B. Data performed with respect to the provision of notice and administration of the Settlement. A.B. Data's total fees and expenses for this matter through May 29, 2026 are \$129,823.96. A.B. Data's fees and expenses for the work performed in conjunction with processing and validating claims, and calculating payment amounts and the initial distribution of check payments (or wires, if requested) at will be no more than \$186,500.

VI. CONCLUSION

12. The implementation of the Notice Plan in this Settlement achieved a reach of at least 80% to potential Settlement Class Members and provided full and proper notice to members of the Settlement Class before the applicable response deadlines
